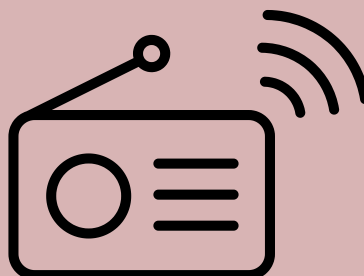

OBJECTIVES

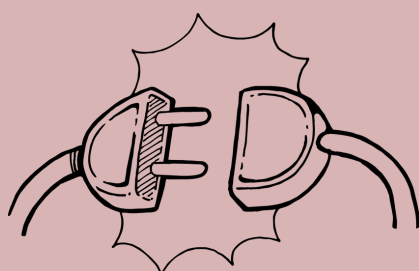
Following the EU's flagship initiative aimed at building a European Education Area by 2025 (COM 2020/625) and the objectives of the European Recommendation on Competitive, Social and Resilient VET (COM 2020/275), the **Roncalli Higher Education Institute** and the **partners of the VET Accreditation Consortium** intend to pursue the ambitious goal of integration between national and international educational goals that - in addition to creating a more motivating approach, integrated and intercultural approach to "knowledge" - is capable of fostering and stimulating the active participation of students in their own education, so that they can become the center and driving force of all educational action, protagonists of a rapidly changing world, curious about knowledge, aware of their own abilities, responsible for their actions in the world.
