

3.Policy makers and local, regional, national and European institutions competent in the VET field




OBJECTIVES

In line with the objectives of the European documents "European Skills Agenda for Sustainable Competitiveness, Social fairness and Resilience" and "European Euduation Area," through **VET LAB 2023**, the VET accreditation consortium, led by the school **Istituto di Istruzione Superiore Bandini** (Siena), aims to improve the quality of vocational education and training, giving a European dimension to the training pathways and thus providing young participants with the opportunity to verify and improve their skills: professionalism in the specific areas of vocational training (**digital and green tourism**, **hotel and restaurant**, **and related and/or complementary**), cultural knowledge and language preparation.

This general objective is pursued through a mobility experience lasting an average of one month for students in **initial vocational training** (including those with Special Educational Needs) from participating vocational training schools.

The training program includes short term (short term) internships in selected companies in the green and digital tourism, tourist accommodation and catering sectors to gain knowledge and skills within the sectors and compare different professional techniques, and activities aimed at insertion and integration in the context and improving language skills and to learn more about the culture of the host country.



EXPECTED IMPACT

The **VET LAB 2023** project has a significant impact on vocational training systems through:

- The achievement of the learning outcomes of the mobility participants;
- The competencies acquired by staff involved in project management;
- The recognition of competencies in an ECVET-compatible framework.

The project also represents an added value and development opportunity for participating organizations, which will be able to consolidate a new training segment to complement technical and vocational training and respond to business demand for high professional green and digital skills.
